Curtis Roth**

Director Roth reported the following:

- Met on March 9-10 in Lincoln
- Provided a summary of the Legislative Conference, NARD may have to look for new location due to size of Embassy
- Washington DC conference March 23-26, 2014 agenda is set
- State Environthon will be held in Alda, NE on May 3. There will be no national competition
- June Board meeting will be held on June 9 in association with the Basin Tour. Basin tour will focus on augmentation projects in the Upper Republican and Twin Platte NRDs.
- NACD Northern Plains Region meeting will be held June 11-13 in Denver, CO

Excused Absences

Dave Carlson moved to excuse John Burke. Dave Kadlecsek seconded the motion. Roll call: (10) ayes, (0) nays, (1) absent: Burke

Public Comment

Charlie Skavdahl thanked the board for their service and explained the priority status of Niobrara River water rights and how water would be used in the future. Mr. Skavdahl expressed concerns over the management of the Niobrara River management through Agate Fossil Beds and the groundwater use in the Wyoming portion of the basin. Mr. Skavdahl suggested the board look at the Niobrara River Compact.

Jim Skavdahl explained that water levels in monitoring wells in Wyoming have dropped 25 feet. Mr. Skavdahl discussed the lawsuit that was filed against the state of Nebraska on the Wyoming compact.

Dan Skavdahl questioned the 15 inch allocation and the logic behind the decision. Mr. Skavdahl and Director Dorshorst had a conversation regarding this. Mr. Skavdahl suggested collecting more data and information. Specifically having NRD staff collect static water levels from every well when reading flow meters. Mr. Skavdahl wanted more information than is provided by the current monitoring wells prior to making decisions. Mr. Skavdahl wanted more information collected to verify the hydrologic connection between the Niobrara River and groundwater and explained that Pumpkin Creek was an anomaly.

Mike Machata explained the hydrology was diverse and complex and recognized the problems in some areas. Mr. Machata suggested instituting allocations in the district is pre-mature and the board should not lump all areas in the district with Box Butte County. Mr. Machata expressed a willingness to participate in future discussions.

Charlie Hamilton thanked the board for listening and for the willingness to serve and was appreciative of the education process.

Mike Colson questioned why the board has chosen to include a carryover restriction in the rules. Mr. Colson would like to work with NRD to address this issue.

Don Grein expressed concerns over the use of water for fracking and suggested the board pay attention to the issue.


Tom Marcy questioned why Sub-area III was being allocated.

Fred Hagman expressed concern over raising alfalfa under the proposed allocation scheme. Explained the river was not good last year. Suggested the board look at soil types and crops for establishing allocations.

Niobrara River Basin Alliance

Director Carlson reported on the following:

- The Alliance met in Valentine on February 19.

Water Committee Report Tod Dorshorst

Director Dorshorst reported on the following:

- There was a request for a transfer of allocation. John Burke has applied to transfer a portion of the remaining allocation from one tract of land to another, there is allocation remaining for the transfer and the request meets the District's rules pertaining to transfers.

The Water Committee recommended approval.

Tod Dorshorst moved to approve the John Burke transfer request; Steve Sandberg seconded the motion. Roll call: (10) ayes, (0) nays, (1) absent: Burke

- There was a request for a variance to the well drilling moratorium. Nebraska Beef Packers – Rudy Stanko has requested to transfer use from certified irrigated acres in order to install a high capacity – 200 gpm well for use in a confined animal feeding operation. An offset will be provided through decertification and non-irrigation of acres.

The Water Committee recommended approval.

Tod Dorshorst moved to approved the Nebraska Beef Packers transfer and variance request. Dave Carlson seconded the motion. Roll call: (10) ayes, (0) nays, (1) absent: Burke.

The Water Committee recommended entering into a contract with Adaptive Resources, Inc. (ARI) a hydrogeologic consulting firm. The contract would be based upon work completed. Prior to each task ARI would provide an estimate of the cost for each work.

Tod Dorshorst motioned to enter into a contract with Adaptive Resources, Inc. Scott Berndt seconded the motion. Roll call: (10) ayes, (0) nays, (1) absent: Burke.

Information from the public hearing for the groundwater rules and regulation will be summarized and distributed to board.

**Mirage Flats Irrigation District

Mr. Brozek submitted a letter to the board on behalf of the Irrigation District supporting the board's efforts to manage groundwater in the district to maintain Niobrara River flows.

Mr. Brozek also explained the MFID's potential project and requested the NRD's assistance with the district's pumping plant and groundwater recharge feasibility study.

Andy Curd

Mr. Curd thanked the board for considering options to the proposed groundwater rules and regulations and offered assistance in developing alternatives to the proposal. Mr. expressed concern over the allocations, and the science being used to make the decisions. Director Dorshorst explained some of the logic associated with the proposed changes.

Pat added the following to his written report:

- Announced Kylen Weingart would be starting as Office Manager on March 31.
- NDEQ has possession of a State of Nebraska emergency response radio
- A map of the NRD water management throughout the state was handed out. The map was developed by Scott Snell, Upper Big Blue NRD.
- Discussed LB 686 – certify non-irrigation status by a specified date. NARD has no changed position on the bill
- Discussed LB 1074, and AM 2360 introduced by Senator Lathrop for the purpose of getting basin wide plans and integrated management plans for the entire district. The impact of AM 2360 would require a basin wide water management plan for the Niobrara Basin. A legislative hearing will be held on March 18, 2014 on AM 2360.
- Niobrara Model presentation will be on March 20, 2014 at 0930.
