



## UPPER NIOBRARA WHITE NATURAL RESOURCES DISTRICT

**Board of Directors' Meeting  
September 11th, 2014**

In accordance with LB 325, Eighty-fourth Legislature, First Session (1975), the Upper Niobrara White Natural Resources District held a public meeting at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 11th, 2014, at the Upper Niobrara White NRD Office in Chadron, NE. An agenda for this meeting to be considered at such date, time and place was kept continually current and was available in the NRD office. Seven days prior to the meeting, the agenda was mailed to each member of the Board of Directors and other interested and affected persons. ### **Open Meeting Law Act**

**NRCS**  
**Robin Foulk**

Robin introduced Victor Micardo, a CSC Graduate student who is currently shadowing at the NRCS office. Mr. Micardo gave a brief introduction.

Robin continued to review her report to the Board. The NRCS is going to reopen the Soil Conservation Technician position in Alliance, after only one application was received during the first application process where only federal employees could apply. This time the position will be open to the public.

The NRCS is also working on Conservation Compliance. This involves wetland determinations, developing conservation plans, and status reviews. NRCS staff must have approval authority to conduct these compliance reviews, which involves extra training for some of the staff. Also, the reviews cannot be done by NRCS employees within their own county; they must be conducted by an NRCS employee working out of another county.

Robin also noted that Audrey Holland will be the new NRCS Administrative Assistant. Her start date will be September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2014.

**Nebraska Forest Service**  
**Doak Nickerson**

Doak gave a report on the Mountain Pine Beetle epidemic that is occurring in the Black Hills area. The forest service believes that the beetle will eventually run out of food as they prefer to eat living trees. The Black Hills National Forest has been in a legal battle with several environmental groups but in the most recent district court ruling, the Forest Service will now be able to go in and thin the forest as necessary.

Doak also discussed the saw log market and entertained questions by some of the Board members regarding the Pine Ridge Area.

The dead elm trees on the back of the NRD property have finally been removed and Doak gave a list of some of the benefits that those trees have provided over their lifespan.

**General Manager**  
**Pat O'Brien**

Pat added the following to his written report:

- Pat discussed the current status of one of the legislative bills regarding public hearings for the NRD's in front of DNR.
- Director Zochol asked for further clarification on the Chemigation Legislation. Pat provided some information on the cost of chemigation permits as well as the cost to the districts to conduct inspections. The legislation will now allow each of the districts to set their own chemigation fees.
- Pat also discussed the Environmental Trust Grant that has been submitted for about \$300,000 to expand the NRD's modeling efforts.

Lynn added the following to his written report:

- Lynn mentioned that the NRD staff is preparing for meter reading.
- The NRD as also put in an application for some funding through Insight Data Enhancement Program (IDEP). The NRD has been approved and will receive funding for Crop Simulation Data as well as data transfer for our water modeling efforts. This funding will totally about \$60,000.

Sheri added the following to her written report:

- The NRD has been doing a lot of field work lately. Over 800 samples have been taken to date.
- Sheri thanked Curtis and Sandy Roth for attending the No Till Bus Tour.
  - Director Roth gave a brief update on the tour.
- Sheri also mentioned that there may be a No Till demonstration at Jim Irwin's in the near future. The next No Till meeting is October 2<sup>nd</sup>.

**Nebraska Association of Resources Districts

- As the NARD voting delegate at the Fall Conference, Director Roth asked for the Board's opinion on the resolutions that he would be voting on, on behalf of the UNWNRD. Pat provided clarification on each of the resolutions and the Board agreed to go forward with each of them.
- The NARD Risk Pool is doing well.
- There will be a Program Planning teleconference that Director Roth will not be able to attend. He asked that Director Dorshorst step in as alternate. Director Dorshorst agreed to sit in on the teleconference.

He suggested that the NRD provide the City of Alliance with seed, trees or use of NRD equipment to complete the project instead.

Tod Dorshorst moved to deny the request from the City of Alliance but to provide the use of seed, trees or equipment to the city instead, John Burke seconded the motion. Roll Call: (10) ayes, (0) nays. Absent: Dave Carlson.

**2014-2015 Tax Request Hearing**

John Burke motioned to open the 2014-2015 Tax Request Hearing, Tod Dorshorst seconded the motion. Roll Call: (10) ayes, (0) nays. Absent: Dave Carlson.

Pat discussed the changes in the tax acting. There was a decrease in tax asking this year from .02165 for 2013-2014 to .020416 for 2014-2015. Director Zochol opened the Tax Request Hearing for discussion. The Board members discussed the increase in Property Valuations throughout the district.
