Natural Resource Conservation Service Robin Foulk

Bryce also explained that with all of the rain there has been good survival on the windbreaks and pines that were planted for the reforestation this spring. He also shared that the Wildland Urban Interface program received two new grants that results in a 75% reimbursement to landowners.
