Natural Resource Conservation Service Robin Foulk

Robin reported that NRCS received \$1.35 million in funding through the Inflation Reduction Act that was obligated in 25 contracts within the district. Robin also shared that the USDA launched new Working Lands Climate Corps to train future conservation and climate leaders on climate-smart agriculture. She also shared sign-up dates for the Conservation Reserve Programs.

Nebraska Forest Service Bryce Gerlach

Bryce reported that they have received 75,000 trees for the Ponderosa Pine Reforestation Program. Bryce also shared a fabric alternative that is made from coconut shells and are more biodegradable. He also provided information on a conference that will be happening in Pierre, SD that focuses on windbreaks.

General Manager Pat O'Brien

Pat discussed an option with the Directors to allow for monthly meetings to be bypassed in the event of limited business. Current statutes require that monthly meetings be held. Moving forward, a resolution will be prepared and submitted for consideration at the Annual Conference.

Assistant Manager Lynn Webster

Lynn reported that staff is preparing to record spring static water levels which will be completed by the end of the month. He also shared that the approved amended rules and regulations become effective on March 14th.

Kylen reported that the Conservation Festival will be on May 1st at Chadron State Park.

Water Resource Manager Haley Anders

Haley reported that she has analyzed the nitrate data for the whole district and will be starting static water levels later in the month.
