## Natural Resource Conservation Service Robin Foulk

Robin gave an update on the Web Soil Survey, which can now be downloaded as an application for a mobile device. Robin explained the cover crop initiative, allowing individuals to apply for assistance in grounds that could not be planted due to natural disasters such as flooding. The initiative has a wide variety of crops it will cover. The deadline is July 19, 2019; there have been 12 sign-ups within the UNW. Robin explained the Conservation Stewardship Program-Grassland Initiative that will assist producers wanting to plant agricultural lands back to grasslands.

#### Nebraska Forest Service Doak Nickerson

Doak shared with the directors the abundance of fruit that is being produced this year. Doak also explained the wide variety of fruit bearing plants/trees that can be planted in our district and will survive. Doak shared some information on fuels moisture with this being the wettest conditions since July 1994. Doak presented information on the potential of approximately 170,000 acres in the state that could be planted with trees. The estimate was made by using center pivot corners. Those 170,000 acres could hold 5 million trees but would take 100 year to plant.

# Adaptive Resources Integrated Thad Kuntz

Thad presented t information on the super positioning conversion of the Upper Niobrara White Integrated Groundwater Model. The conversion of the model will provide a tool to evaluate the impacts of transfers on groundwater levels in the area. Directors asked several questions about the process and how the tool could be used moving forward with groundwater management decisions.

## General Manager Pat O'Brien

Pat added the following to his written report:
